


EVICTIION NOTICE


The tenant Dane has been found in violation of Apis Mellifera Residential Hive Association conduct statute 08.20, which states that all residents must contribute to winter hive sustainability and survival via the working tasks listed, but not limited to brood care, guarding, wax building, foraging, fanning, nectar transfer, pollen storage, or honestly anything useful. Further, it states that mating with The Queen and eating association honey stores does not fit within the parameters of this statute. The tenant Dane is hereby ordered to vacate the premises of the hive immediately.

The tenant Dane has until the first day of autumn to remove himself from the premises. Purchasing a beverage of choice by the due date of 8/18/16 for either or both The Queen and the Lead Worker will extend your eviction deadline by 5 business days. Failure to comply may result in forceful, painful, or even lethal removal from the premises by sister workers. This may result in wrenched wings, bitten antennae, leg segment removal, and eye stinging, and pure carnage left behind.
